Unison Credit Union awards up to three \$1,000 scholarships to the individuals who best mirror the credit union philosophy of "people helping people" and who have learned the importance of volunteerism and giving back to his or her community.

Scholarship Eligibility and Information:

- Student or parent/guardian must be a member of Unison Credit Union.
- Graduating high school senior will enter a two or four year degree program at a college, university or technical school.
- Applications are scored based on the following areas:

Community Support/Volunteerism	70%
Academics	10%
Co-Curricular Activities	10%
Employment	10%
- Please answer all questions and do not use acronyms (i.e., use American Cancer Society, not ACS).
- Winners of the scholarship will be notified at the school's awards presentation. If the student is not present, the student will then be notified by mail.
- The \$1,000 scholarship will be paid out in two increments. In order to receive the scholarship proceeds, you must present proof of enrollment at your school of choice (e.g., copy of class schedule or invoice). The check will be made out to the student. It is the student's responsibility to contact Unison when his or her invoice has been issued.
- The scholarship application packet must be complete and submitted by **Saturday, March 27** at noon to:
